A. Situations Concerning Student Career Development in AY 2011

Director Hoshi of the Student Affairs Division gave an explanation on this subject based on the document which had been distributed to member of the Council. There were opinions and comments on the subject as follows:

- O Was there any impact of the Fukushima nuclear power plants accident on students had found employment in AY 2011 in Fukushima Prefecture?
- \rightarrow I believe not.

Would it be possible to make use of the 100% employment rate of graduates of the Master's Program to promote the interest of students of the Undergraduate School in advancement to the Graduate School?

- → It must be effective if students are provided with this information by faculty members. This information will also be given to students' guardians through the Supporters' Association.
- O What kind of career paths are they included in the "Other" category?
- → Students who failed civil servant examinations and are preparing for one next and those who are preparing for entrance examinations for graduate schools other than the University of Aizu Graduate School are classified as "Other."
- O Does the number in the category, "Outside Fukushima", include the number of international students who found employment overseas or those who returned to

their home counties after graduation?

- → Students who found employment in companies in Japan are included in "In Fukushima" or "Outside Fukushima". International students who returned to their home countries were classified as "Other."
- I have heard that one-third of university graduates quit their companies within three years after employment. If we could keep in contact with our graduates to follow up on their situations after graduation, and obtain data on their employment, such as whether they keep working for the companies they were initially employed, such data could be used as materials for explanation to our students and their guardians.
- → It may be difficult to keep accurate track of employment situations regarding graduates of the University. If we could combine data on our graduates input to an integrated database by the Student Affairs Division in AY 2011 with data possessed by the Alumni Association this year, updating of the combined data will hopefully make it easier to obtain information about our graduates after employment.
- O In order to keep contact with our graduates, we could also change the effective period for forwarding e-mails sent to their student IDs to addresses designated by them from several months after graduation to forever.
- O With the use of a social network service, we will be able to communicate with our graduates, even with those residing outside Japan.
- O I have always believed that the University should strengthen the network with its graduates. Not just for creation of a community, it will lead to expansion of job opportunities for our students through close ties between the University and graduates, and may make graduates think about sending their children to the University in the future.

B. The University of Aizu Revitalization Newsletter

Director General Hasegawa of the Administrative Office gave an explanation on this subject based on the document which had been distributed to members of the Council, followed by questions and suggestions summarized below.

To whom have these newsletters been sent?

- \rightarrow They were sent to the mass media and related organizations, and posted on the University website.
- O I would like to request that consideration be given to generation of mailing lists and sending of the newsletter to alumni, which will help to promote the University? The budget for international activities of the revitalization-related projects should be used to pay for travel expenses not only to individuals who will participate in international conferences held at the University from overseas but also to those from outside Fukushima Prefecture.
- → International conferences with the participation of prominent researchers from overseas are more likely to be taken up in the media, which will lead to increasing recognition of the University as well as the Aizu region. Therefore, with the limited budget, priority should be given to conference participants from overseas

whose travel expenses are more expensive than those of participants from within Japan. For this reason, only travel expenses for participants from overseas will be paid for with this budget.
