UoA Establishing All-English Undergraduate Course

In FY2014, the UoA was selected for the MEXT Top Global University Project as a Type B (Globalization Driver Category) funding recipient. This project is aiming to enhance the international competitiveness of Japan's higher education.

In order to produce innovative ICT talents who will play leading roles on the global stage, and as part of an initiative to promote further internationalization of the university, the UoA is establishing an "ICT Global Program All-English Undergraduate Course." A new entrance examination system will be utilized in an effort to build a multicultural campus mainly through document screening, which is more convenient for applicants from other countries.

ICT Global Program All-English Undergraduate Course

- Study all courses in English from admission to graduation.
- Admission capacity: A few individuals
- Date of admission: October 1, 2016
- Nationality and the country/language of pre-university education are not considered. Accordingly, applicants graduating from high schools in Japan are also eligible.
- To apply, applicants must be qualified for admission to a university in Japan and submit scores of an English proficiency test (either of TOEIC, TOEFL iBT, IELTS or the EIKEN test) and one of the examinations designated by the university*1 (IB, SAT or EJU).
- Selection is conducted through document screening.*2

Other than the entrance examination indicated above, examinations for advanced standing admission will be conducted for international applicants enrolled at UoA partner universities.

- *2 If necessary, oral examinations might be conducted through interviews in an applicant's own country or by Skype/telephone interviews.
