UoA Student Kagome NAYA received the Best Paper Prize at the IEEE Sendai Student Awards 2018 Ceremony

On Thursday, December 13, 2018, the IEEE Sendai Student Awards 2018 ceremony was held at the main building of the Research Institute of Electrical Communication in Tohoku University. At the ceremony, Kagome NAYA (1st year master student of Computer Science and Engineering student supervised by Professor Toshiaki MIYAZAKI) was awarded the Best Paper Prize.

The prize winners were decided based on the evaluation results of the presentations made by students at the 2018 Tohoku-Section Joint Convention of Institutes of Electrical and Information Engineers, which was held at the Ueda Campus of Hirosaki University on September 6 (Thu) and 7 (Fri), 2018.



Computer Communications Lab won the Best Paper Award at 9th ICTC 2018

A research article from the Computer Communications Laboratory (CCL) won the Best Paper Award at the 9th International Conference on ICT Convergence (ICTC) 2018 in Jeju, Korea.

The ICTC conference is organized by The Korean Institute of Communications and Information Sciences (KICS) and technically co-sponsor by IEEE Communications Society and IEICE Communications Society.

ICTC is a unique global premier event for researchers, industry professionals, and academics, which aims at interacting with and disseminating information on the latest developments in the emerging industrial convergence centered around the information and communication technologies.

Hoang Le, the first author of the paper, attends the conference and receives the award on behalf of all co-authors, including the collaborators: Dr. Vuong Mai (KAIST) – the former PhD student at the CCL and Dr. Chuyen Nguyen (HUST) – former Visiting Researcher at the CCL.

On October 17, 2018, World Robot Challenge 2018, the robot competition in an event of World Robot Summit 2018 was held, and the team of UoA (REL/UoA) won the 1st place in the category of Tunnel Disaster Response and Recovery Challenge. Also, in the category of Standard Disaster Robotics Challenge, the team REL/UoA competed solidly and came in the 13th place among 19 teams from around the world.



Blockchain Technology" Class Begins at the University of Aizu

The University of Aizu began teaching "Blockchain Technology" in October 2018. In the Aizu region, the University of Aizu has been involved in several blockchain demonstration experiments for the past two years, ahead of the rest of the country. In this class, lectures will be given in cooperation with companies in the Tokyo metropolitan area on the development of ICT human resources to support virtual currencies, with a focus on the use of technology.
