

The Outline for the All-Japan High School Computing Contest Executive Committee

Article One

(Objective)

1.1 This outline, based upon the provisions of Article 31 of the University Regulation Concerning the Internal Administrative Organization and Other Aspects of the University of Aizu (Regulation No. 10, April 1, 2006), provides for the method of administration and other necessary matters concerning the All-Japan High School Computing Contest (hereinafter, “PC-*Koshien*”) Executive Committee (hereinafter, “Committee”).

Article Two

(Matters for Deliberation)

2.1 The Committee shall deliberate on the following matters:

- (1) Administration of PC-*Koshien* contest, and creating problems for the Programming Division contest
- (2) Other matters necessary for implementing contest

Article Three

(Organization)

3.1 The Committee shall be organized of the following individuals. The Committee Chairperson shall be served by the University President.

- (1) The University President
- (2) The Deputy Director General Assigned to the University Administrative Office
- (3) Up to 10 members appointed by the University President

Article Four

(Term of Office)

4.1 The term of office of the Committee members shall be two years. These members can be reappointed.

4.2 Notwithstanding the preceding paragraph, in the event that there is a vacancy during the term of office, the vacancy must promptly be filled. The term of office of a member to fill the vacancy shall be the remainder of the vacated term.

Article Five

(Meetings)

5.1 The Committee Chairperson shall convoke meetings and serve as the chair thereof.

5.2 Should the Committee Chairperson be unable to fulfill his/her duties, the individual previously designated by the Committee Chairperson shall fulfill these duties on the Committee Chairperson's behalf.

Article Six

(Attendance by Related Individuals)

6.1 The Committee Chairperson, when he or she recognizes doing so as necessary, may request the attendance of related nonmembers for the purpose of having them provide explanations or opinions.

Article Seven

(Working Group)

7.1 The Committee may establish a working group as necessary, in order to discuss matters stipulated in Article 2 from technical perspectives.

7.2 The working group shall be organized of individuals designated by the Committee Chairperson.

Article Eight

(General Affairs)

8.1 General affairs related to the Committee shall be performed by the Planning and Collaboration Division.

Article Nine

(Supplemental Provisions)

9.1 Other than those provided for by these regulations, necessary matters concerning the administration of the Committee shall be determined separately by the Committee Chairperson by way of consultation with the Committee.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

1. These regulations shall be enforced as of April 1, 2015.
