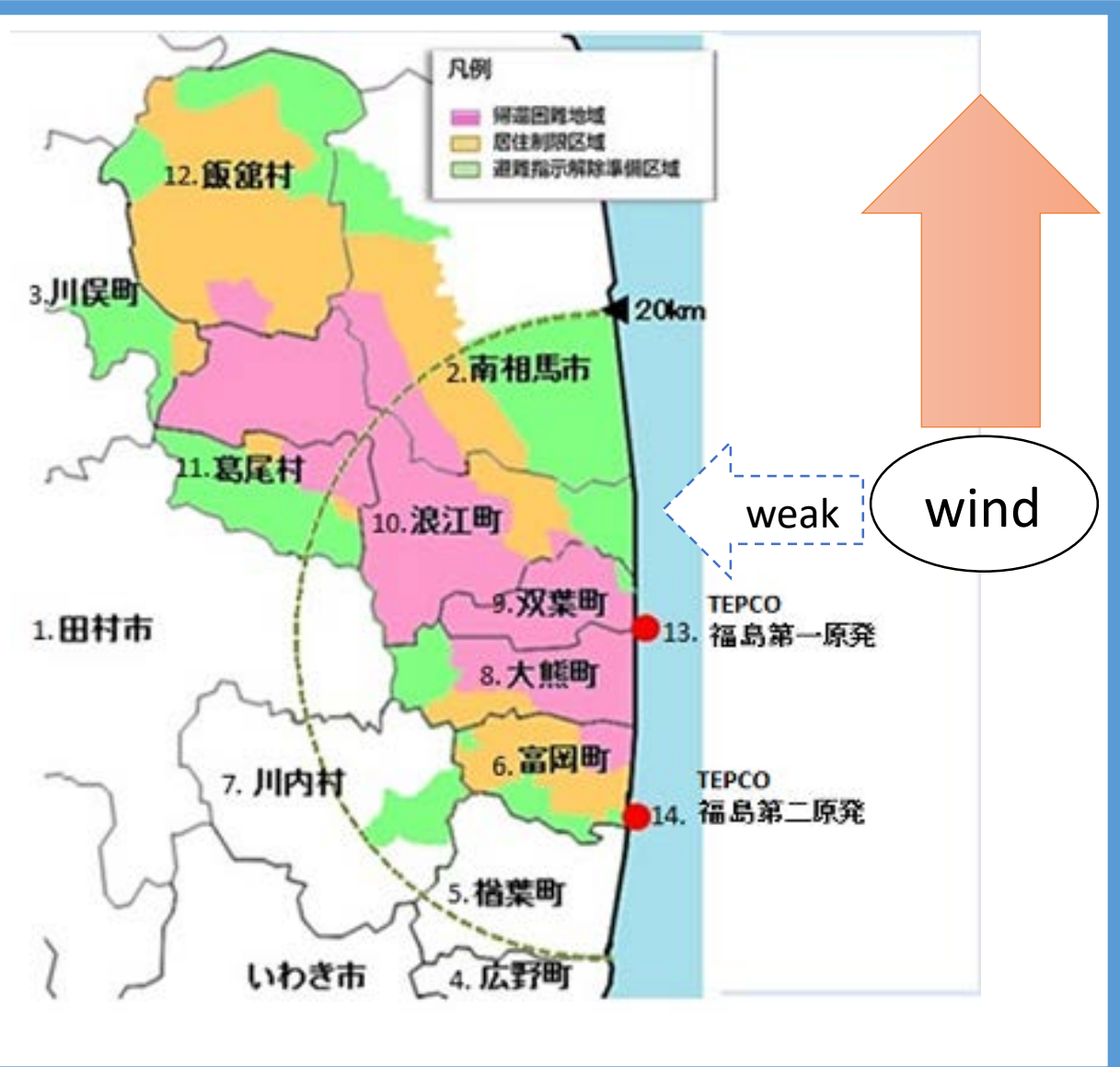
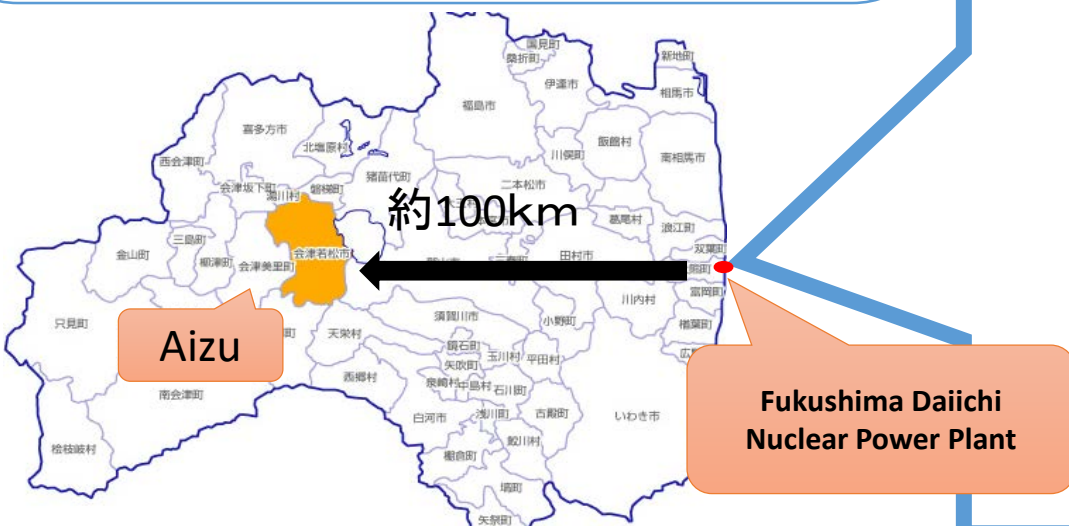


Aizu is a Safe Area in Fukushima

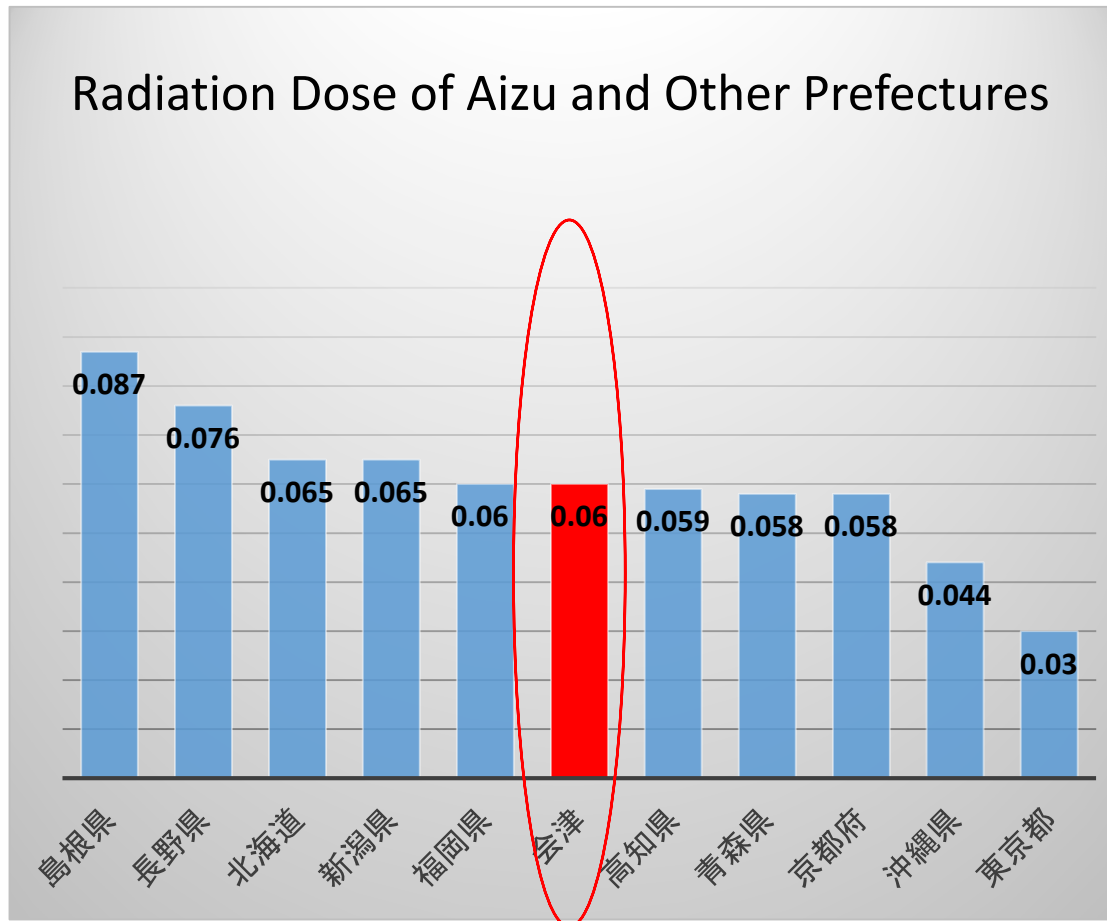
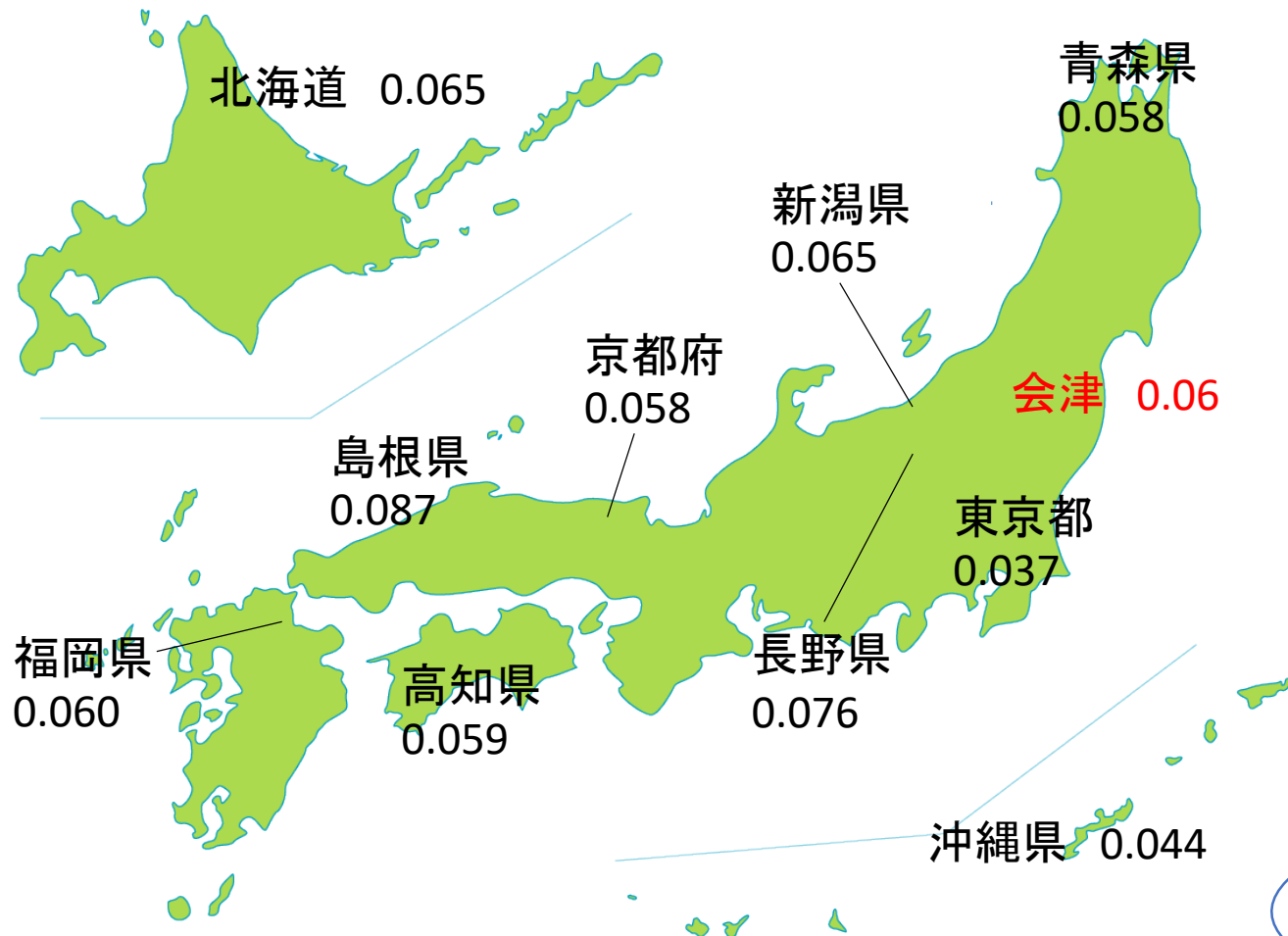
Aizu area had little effect from the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear disaster.

- Aizu area is far from the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant
- Aizu area is surrounded by mountains
- Aizu area is out of the downwind direction of disaster area

Actually, many people evacuated to Aizu after the nuclear disaster.



Comparison with Other Prefectures in Japan

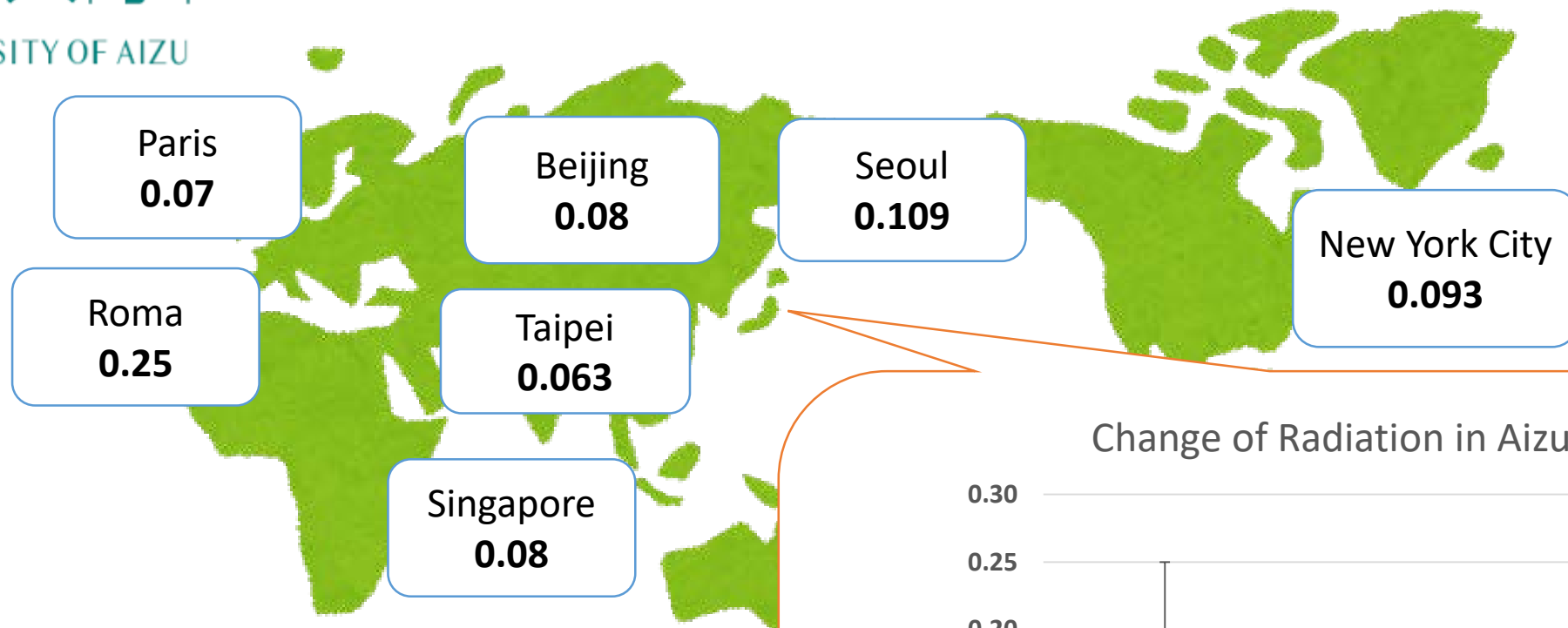

Radiation dose in Aizu-wakamatsu city shows the average level comparing with other regions in Japan and is almost at the same level as other countries.

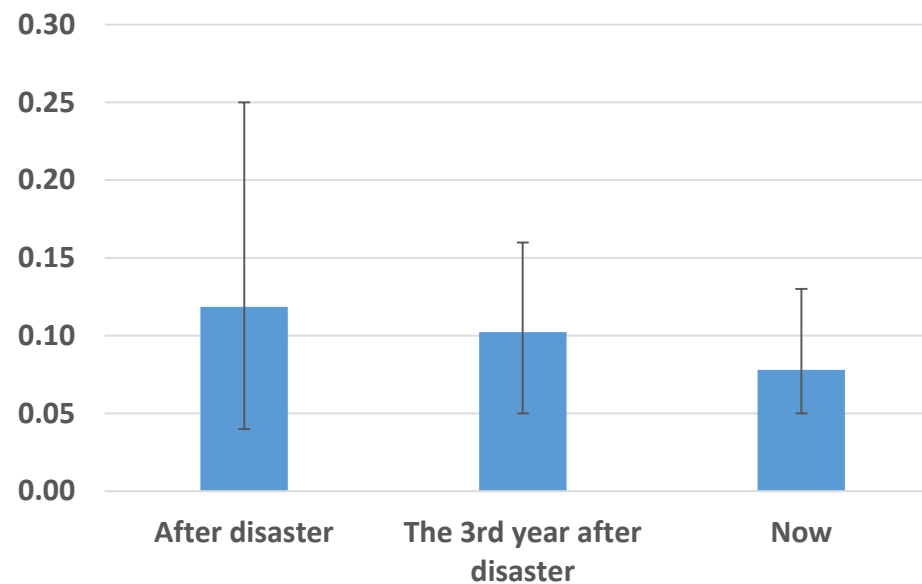
Comparison with Other Cities in the World
